- Marie Claire provided a wonderful array of snacks and beverages.

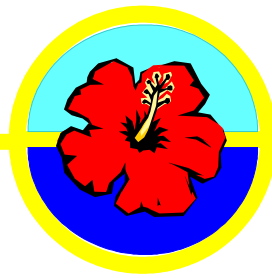
Treasurer (Judy Rae)

- Circumnavigation of Catalina (July 27-31): Boats Participating: Little Sister, Catspaw, Adios, Karma, Moon Child, Aurora
 - Thursday: White's Cove – Mooring, Cocktails aboard Catspaw.
 - Friday: Big Geiger Cove – Anchor, BBQ on beach
 - Anchor (fore & aft) guidelines
 - Circle area once to get the lay of the cove
 - Drop the stern anchor & pay out 180' of rode
 - Drop the bow anchor & back (pulling stern anchor line) to 90'
 - Saturday: Little Harbor – Anchor, Cocktails aboard Aurora
 - Anchor (fore & aft) guidelines
 - Drop the bow anchor
 - Place the stern anchor in a dingy and row to the beach.
 - Sunday: Avalon – Mooring, Dinner plans to be announced
 - Be prepared to raft up if needed.
